DISTRIBUTION OF FOOD

During the financial year 2020–2021, Titan Biotech Limited spent **₹10,91,500** towards Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activities. The CSR contribution was made to **Omkar Andh-Apang Samajik Sanstha**, an implementing agency, under Item No. 1 of Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013, focusing on eradicating hunger, poverty and malnutrition, promoting healthcare (including preventive healthcare), sanitation, and access to safe drinking water.

Omkar Andh-Apang Samajik Sanstha, established in 2010 and registered under the Mumbai Trust Act and Section 80(G) of the Income Tax Act, works for the empowerment of visually impaired, disabled, and underprivileged individuals. The Trust undertakes initiatives in education, healthcare, sanitation, livelihood, housing, and water resources, with the objective of creating an inclusive and dignified society for persons with disabilities.

EDUCATION, HEALTH, AND COVID-19 RELIEF

During the financial year 2021–2022, Titan Biotech Limited contributed **₹33,24,000** towards Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) to **RLR Education Foundation**, a Section 8 company under the Companies Act, 2013, under Item No. II of Schedule VII, to promote education, including special education, vocational skill development, and livelihood enhancement for children, women, the elderly, and the differently abled. RLR Education Foundation is setting up a primary school on a one-acre land in Panipat, Haryana, as its first project and is in the process of acquiring an additional five acres for a senior secondary school.

During the same year, the Company also contributed **₹1,00,000** to the **Delhi Sikh Gurudwara Management Committee** (DSGMC) under Items I & XII of Schedule VII for a COVID-19 Facilitation Centre.

ANIMAL WELFARE AND EDUCATION

During the financial year 2022–2023, Titan Biotech Limited undertook Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives amounting to ₹50,65,000, aligned with the activities prescribed under Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013.. An amount of **₹2,50,000** was allocated towards Welfare of Cows falling under Item No. IV of Schedule VII in Jhajjar District, Haryana, through **Kamdhenu-Mangal Parivar** (Regd.), aimed at promoting animal welfare and sustainable care practices.

Further, the Company contributed its remaining CSR funds amounting to **₹48,15,000** to was contributed towards Development and Promotion of Education in Alwar District, Rajasthan, covered under Item No. II of Schedule VII through **Durga Memorial Welfare Society**, a non-profit implementing agency supporting educational advancement and capacity building.

EDUCATION

During the financial year 2023-24, Titan Biotech Limited undertook a CSR project relating to the construction of school buildings/rooms under the Education sector during the reporting period. The project was implemented in the State of Haryana, specifically in Jhajjar District, through **Shree Charan Singh Welfare Society**, an implementing agency. The total amount spent on the project aggregated to **₹63,90,000**, reflecting the Company's commitment towards strengthening educational infrastructure and promoting access to quality education.

ANIMAL WELFARE AND EDUCATION

During the financial year 2024-25, Titan Biotech Limited implemented multiple Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) projects through eligible implementing agencies in accordance with Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013. CSR initiatives were undertaken in the areas of Animal Welfare and Education, including school building construction and distribution of education material, across various states.

Under the Animal Welfare sector, a project was undertaken in Deeg District, Rajasthan, through **Shree Brij Kamad Surabhi Van Avam Shodh Sansthan**, with a total expenditure of **₹53.10 lakhs** incurred as direct project expenditure.

In the Education sector, the Company supported projects in Nangloi, Delhi (NCT) through **Krishna Welfare Trust**, with an expenditure of **₹6.00 lakhs**. The amount of **₹0.51 lakhs** was allocated towards the Welfare of Cows in Jhajjar District, Haryana, through **Kamdhenu-Mangal Parivar**, with the objective of promoting animal welfare and sustainable care practices.
